

PACKET PICK-UP (BULL RUN)

&

REGISTRATION (BULL RING) DETAILS

How Bull Run works:

The annual Bull Run is simply a drive-through registration packet pick-up. ET staff members are set up in the Serrano (the pool side) parking lot. Parents drive through, show the postcard for identification purposes, and pick up the packet of information.

Bull Run is held on:

8/4/09 from 8 am to 11 am
8/4/09 from 8 am to 11 am
8/6/09 from 4:30 to 6:30 pm



Parents unable to pick up the packet at Bull Run will have to come to the office during summer office hours (8 am to noon M-F) and show the postcard.

These documents are not provided here to replace the actual packet, but simply for reference purposes. Registration packets must be picked up in person using the postcard to ensure your student is enrolled and will be able to register at Bull Ring registration.

How Bull Ring works:

Bull Ring Registration is from 7 am to noon in the Auxillary Gym on:

August 17 (Seniors)
August 18 (Juniors)
August 19 (Sophomores)
August 20 (Freshmen)

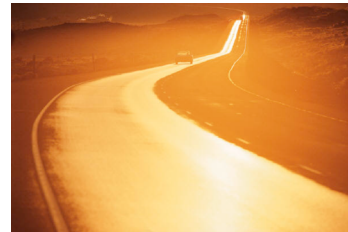


Make-up registration for all grade levels is August 24 from 7:30 am to 10:30 am.

Students who are unable to make either date will register on the first day of school.

Students may NOT register on a day other than their grade level day or the make-up day.

Students proceed through a series of 8 stations as follows:



Station 1: Auxillary Gym (turn in completed Emergency Card - NCR form with 4 copies)

Station 2: Auxillary Gym (turn in signed Blue Card)

Station 3: Science Building (pick up pre-coded scan card)*

Station 4: Science Building (Make ASB purchases)**

Station 5: Science Building (Pick up ASB purchases)

Station 6: Science Building (Pick up PE clothes and locks)

Station 7: Science Building (Take Yearbook/ID card picture)

Station 8: Science Building (Pick up class schedule)***

*Must clear debt if on Debt List before continuing the registration process.

**Bring receipt if you purchased items on line at the ET Web Store.

***See a guidance technician in the office if there is a conflict on the class schedule.

***See Mrs. Donohue in the ROP office to add Fall ROP classes.
