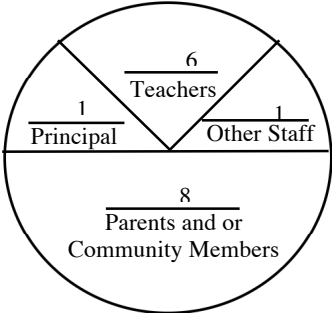


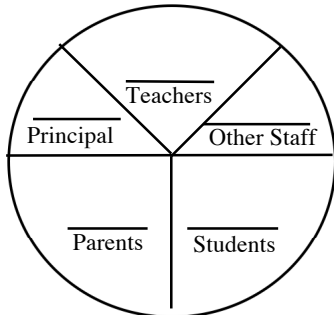

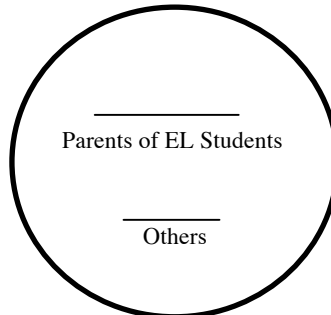
Enter the number of members on the appropriate diagram



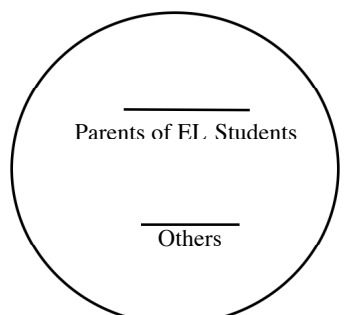
