

April 18, 2022 COVID-19 Vaccination Not Required for Students 2022-2023

Hello SVUSD Community,

During Spring Break, the California Department of Public Health announced that the COVID-19 vaccination will not be required for students to attend school during the 2022-2023 school year.

On April 14, 2022, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released new guidance regarding adding the COVID-19 vaccine to the list of vaccinations to attend school. The federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has not fully approved the COVID-19 vaccine for individuals within the 7-12 grade age span. Therefore, the COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements in Schools states:

"To ensure sufficient time for successful implementation of new vaccine requirements, California will not initiate the regulatory process for a COVID-19 vaccine requirement for the 2022-2023 school year and as such, any vaccine requirements would not take effect until after full FDA approval and no sooner than July 1, 2023."

As from the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, Saddleback Valley Unified School District (SVUSD) continues to follow CDPH guidance for the health and safety of its students and staff. **SVUSD will not require the COVID-19 vaccination for students for the 2022-2023 school year.**
