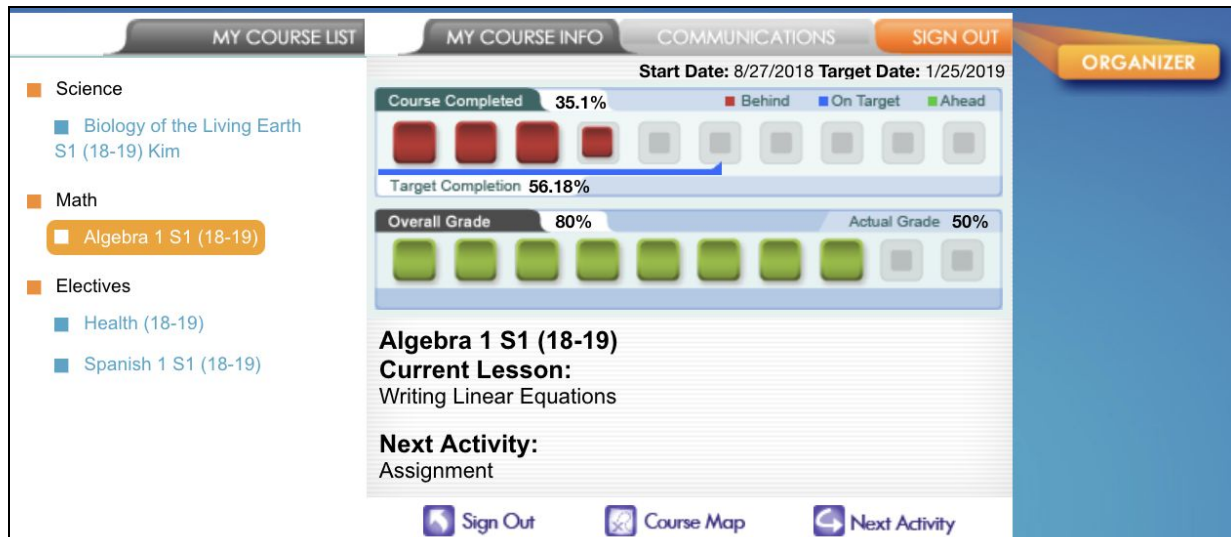
SVUSD Virtual Academy blends online coursework with classroom instruction. For some courses, students will be enrolled in a course created by Edgenuity. Students will primarily complete assignments, quizzes and tests in Edgenuity while their teacher provides support, guidance, and accountability.

Student progress can be monitored through Edgenuity. Parents will receive weekly emails to update them of their student's progress in Edgenuity. (Assignment grades will not be posted in the Aeries family portal.) Parents will have access to the Edgenuity Parent Portal upon request.

Understanding Edgenuity Progress Reporting



There are four elements that inform you of the progress your student is making in a specific course.

- Course Completed percentage vs Target Completion percentage:**
 - Course Completion* is the percentage of the course your student has completed.
 - Target Completion* is the percentage of the course that your student should have completed to stay on pace. The color-coded completion squares indicate your student's progress:
 - Red:** Your student is falling behind.
 - Blue:** Your student is on track.
 - Green:** Your student is ahead of schedule.
- Overall Grade:** the grade that reflect your student's grade on only the work they have completed.
- Actual Grade:** This is a student's current grade in the course taking into consideration all activities, tests, quizzes, and tests, assigned up to date. This includes zeros if your student is behding. **(THIS IS THE NUMBER A PARENT SHOULD MONITOR)**
- Relative Grade:** this is the grade a student would earn if they did not do any of the remaining assignments.
