TIME:

Period 1 (8:30 am - 10:15 am)*; Period 2 (10:30 am - 12:15 pm)*

***each student will be randomly assigned to Period 1 or Period 2.** Students period assignments will be available on the SVUSD Family Portal the week prior to the start of summer school.

REGISTRATION:

- **BEGINS MONDAY, APRIL 1, 2019**
- **Students may enroll in one course each session.**
- **Current 9th - 12th grade students:** Return the completed registration form, signed by **both** parent/guardian and student, to the current high school's Guidance Office.

WHO MAY ENROLL:

- SVUSD summer school courses are only available to students who will attend SVUSD high schools in fall 2019, SVUSD non-grad seniors, and students who live within SVUSD boundaries. Courses are available only to current high school students who need to repeat a course already taken.

COURSES OFFERED:

- SCIENCE: earth science, biology, and chemistry
- MATH: algebra 1, geometry, and algebra 2

CLASS OF 2019:

To receive a diploma from a comprehensive high school in the SVUSD, a student must be in attendance at a comprehensive high school for their last semester prior to graduation. A student may receive a comprehensive high school diploma if all requirements are completed by the end of Summer School, Session A (July 3).

ATTENDANCE & PROGRESSION:

Daily student attendance is mandatory; lack of attendance is cause for dismissal from summer school. See page 2 for attendance guidelines. In addition to class-time, it is expected that students will work an 2-3 hours/day on their online coursework. Students who fall more than two (2) days behind the course progress expectations may be dropped with no credit earned.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

NOTIFICATION OF PERIOD ASSIGNMENT:

Once a registration form is submitted and processed by the Guidance Office, students **will not receive a confirmation of enrollment.** Students should keep pages 1 and 2 as a reference. **Students period assignments will be posted on the SVUSD Family Portal the week prior to June 17.**

Decisions about summer school classes are contingent upon enrollment and facility/staff availability and will be determined by the first day of each session.

2019 HIGH SCHOOL MATH & SCIENCE CREDIT RECOVERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL RULES IN EFFECT DURING THE REGULAR SCHOOL YEAR ARE IN EFFECT DURING SUMMER SCHOOL.
SUMMER SCHOOL IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT.

Attendance: A student cannot accrue more than six (6) attendance points for each three week session for any reason.

- Students who accrue more than five (6) attendance points will be dropped from the class with no credit earned (NM).
- If a student is absent more than 60 minutes (or all day absence) = 3 attendance points.
- If a student is tardy to class 30 - 59 minutes = 2 attendance points.
- If a student is tardy to class 1 - 30 = 1 attendance point.

Adequate Course Progress: Students have three weeks to complete each course.

- Students who fall more than two (2) days behind the course progress expectations may be dropped from the course with no credit earned (NM).
- It is expected that students will work 2-3 hours outside of class to complete all of the required course work.

Closed Campus: Campus is CLOSED during summer school. Students must remain on campus throughout the school day. The student parking lot is off limits during summer school hours. Students who must leave campus before the end of the school day must bring a note from their parent/guardian explaining the reason for early dismissal. This must be presented to the office BEFORE leaving campus. Non summer school students are not allowed on campus during summer school hours.

Drugs/Alcohol Use or Possession: Drug and alcohol use or possession is not allowed at school. This includes going to and from school. All offenders will be immediately dropped from summer school and referred to the District for possible expulsion.

Smoking/Vaping: Smoking or vaping is not permitted on campus or within a city block of the campus. Tobacco products and/or e-cigarettes of any kind are not allowed. Violations of these rules are grounds for dismissal from summer school.

Fighting: No fighting or threat of harm is permitted in or near the school. Violations of these rules are grounds for dismissal from summer school.

Use of Knives/Firecrackers, Etc. The use or possession of knives, firecrackers or any dangerous weapon or look-alikes is not permitted. Police and/or fire department will be called in most cases. All offenders will be immediately dropped from summer school and referred to the District for possible expulsion.

Dress Code: All dress code rules in effect during the regular school year also apply during summer school. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times at school. No bandanas or gang attire can be worn.

Defiance of Authority: Students must be cooperative when dealing with any member of the school staff. Verbal abuse and defiance of authority will not be tolerated at any time. Defiance may result in immediate removal from the summer school program with loss of credit.

Items Not Allowed At Summer School: No radios, laser pens, or skateboards are allowed on campus. They may be confiscated. Cell phones cannot be visible and must be turned off when a student is in the classroom. Cell phones may be used before/after school and during scheduled breaks. The District does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen cell phones.

Repeated Classroom Misbehavior: Students are responsible for appropriate classroom behavior and following classroom rules. Repeated offenses may result in removal from summer school.

Theft/Vandalism: Theft or destruction of personal or school property is grounds for removal from summer school.

Transportation: Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
