




Overview of Edgenuity for Parents



SVUSD Virtual Academy blends online coursework with teacher support and instruction. Each student is assigned to an SVUSD teacher who will support, monitor, and assess students'



progress as students complete assignments, quizzes and tests in Edgenuity, an online education platform. Edgenuity provides standards-based, online curriculum. Each course has been customized by the SVUSD teachers who will monitor, assess, and support students as they progress through the lessons, assignments, and tests.

Using their SVUSD username and ID, students will log into their Edgenuity course at: learn.edgenuity.com/student. Once they log in, the home page (left) provides students with a snapshot of their progress and grade. Next, students will

click over to the Course Map (right) which provides them with a list of their activities, the date they need to complete the activity, and the estimated amount of time it will take them to complete each activity.

Attendance & Progress

- Students must meet with their teacher as needed or scheduled by the instructor.
- Students must stay within 10% of the target completion rate.
- Students who do not attend their scheduled appointments or stay within 10% of the target completion rate may be dropped from the class.
- Students who do not complete their assigned courses by the end of the enrollment period will earn only partial credits.

Student Responsibility

Online learning requires students to be more responsible for and ACTIVE in their learning. Students must organize and manage their time to complete their assignments on-time, be **ACTIVE** in learning the material, ask questions of the curriculum and seek teacher support, and students must attend class everyday, on-time.

Parent Responsibility


Parents are a key component to student academic success. By providing the structure their student needs to succeed.

Top 3 Things Parents Can Do to Support Their Student

1. **Organization Support:** have your student identify a workspace free of distractions and a consistent time that they will work on their online coursework on a daily basis.
2. **Accountability:** ensure that your student attends their scheduled appointment and meets or exceeds the target course progress. You can ask them to log into their Edgenuity account and show you their actual grade and their course progress. It is vital that they stay “on target”. Additionally, you will receive a weekly email detailing their online course progress.
3. **Encouragement:** focus your encouragement on your student’s effort and encourage them not to give up with they are struggling to understand a concept. Encourage them to use their resources by communicating with their teacher. Online-blended learning requires more active student involvement.

- You want to make sure that the amount of work they have completed (course completed) is equal to the amount they should have completed (target completed).
- **ACTUAL** grade: this is your student’s grade accounting for work they have completed and any work that is missing (overdue).
