NETWORK ACCESS POLICY

Students: You are signing the network/internet access form stating, "... network is a privilege and may be revoked at any time."

Infractions are two levels-offenses to be addressed at the administrative level and those to be addresses at the classroom teacher level.

Administrative levels includes:

1. Accessing inappropriate and unauthorized sites, i.e. pornography, harassment, bombs. Substance abuse, objectionable language, anything racist or hate related, sites based upon acting irresponsible, unethical, or illegal, that do not support the curriculum, or offering membership in any unauthorized activity.
2. Access chat rooms/Facebook during any class from 8:25 am – 1:34 pm, after a teacher has written a referral documenting occurrences and called home.
3. Accessing internet when told not to do so by teacher, after a referral and a call home. This includes being off-task when working on an internet assignment,
4. Accessing another user's account without authorization.
5. Vandalizing any component of the network
6. Revealing home address or phone number of one's self or of another person (needs to be done at home by instructor).

Classroom teacher level includes first offenses of 2, 3 and 6. Consequences are:

1. Classroom level offense – up to 3 days off network by teacher and to be reinstated by same teacher for the first offense – then goes to administrative level.
2. Administrative level offense – possible loss of access until end of trimester, student/parent seeks reinstatement of privileges from administration.
