

Enrollment *IN 4 EASY* Steps



- 1 Apply for admission to Saddleback College at saddleback.edu/admissions/apply-saddleback-college and receive your college student identification number.
- 2 Contact your high school academic advisor, or visit saddleback.edu/admissions/high-school-k-8-students and download the Special Admission Request K-12 Students form.
- 3 Complete the Special Admission Request K-12 Students form, have it signed by your school administrator and parent, and submit it to the Admissions and Records Office at scadmissions@saddleback.edu.
- 4 Register for your courses at mysite.socccd.edu utilizing your Saddleback College student identification number.
 - Additional opportunities to take college-level courses are available. Visit saddleback.edu/cs for the full schedule.
 - Enrollment/tuition free college courses offered to 9th – 12th grade students that do not hold a non-immigrant visa.
 - High school students are responsible for paying Student and Health fees (\$23), and any required textbooks or materials for their course(s).
 - Courses with a prerequisite must be cleared at least two weeks prior to enrollment. Information about clearing prerequisites is available at saddleback.edu/matriculation/Clearing-Prerequisites.
