## Message from the Principal

Welcome to our Summer Newsletter! Less than a month ago, we had the privilege to celebrate 485 outstanding graduates from the Class of 2020. It was great taking graduation photos with the seniors in the stadium and the senior car parade was memorable! As I noted in my senior video message, I have no doubt the Class of 2020 will meet any challenge with strength, resiliency, and kindness. We would like to wish our graduates the very best in their future and you will always be part of the Mission Viejo High School Diablo family.

Here are a few highlights and achievements for the 2019/20 school year: \$5.5 million was awarded in **scholarships** to the Class of 2020 and 112 seniors who enrolled in the Counseling 100 course-College Success on our campus earned a collective total of \$616,000 from the Saddleback College Promise Scholarship.

MVHS graduated 30 **Full International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Candidates**, 10 **Commended National Merit Scholars** and 1 **National Merit Finalist**. In May, our IB students completed rigorous internal assessments. In addition, 620 students took approximately 940 **Advanced**

**Placement** exams. It is important to note that even though our overall student enrollment continues to decline based on our attendance area, the number of students taking AP courses continue to increase. We are so proud of the dedication of our students.

Recently, MVHS received an award as a **2020 Best High School in U.S. News and World Report!** We are ranked #412 out of thousands in the state of California in this prestigious publication.

MVHS Drama department received awards including 1st place at the OC RoleAbout theatre festival, competing against 26 schools under the stellar leadership of Mrs. Kathy Cannarozzi Harris. Choral, Jazz, and Wind Ensembles captured awards and hearts virtually.

The Marching Band and Color Guard captured the title of 2019 3A Class Championship! They took 1<sup>st</sup> place in high auxiliary and high percussion. In addition, they won 1<sup>st</sup> place in high music, high effect, and high percussion at the WBA championships.

AVID had another standout year, MUN competed at home and abroad, and agriscience went virtual. We are proud of all the amazing programs at MVHS.



In athletics, the Water Polo team earned the titles of 2019 Boys Water Polo CIF Division Champions and the So Cal Boys Division III-2019 CIF Champions. Boys Basketball, Girls Soccer, Girls Volleyball, Boys and Girls Cross Country all advanced to CIF. The Boys Soccer program had an exceptional season and advanced to the CIF-SS Division 1 semifinals. The Varsity Football team finished their season with an undefeated record, League Championship, and advanced to the CIF-SS Division 1 semifinals. In addition, Mission Viejo student-athletes earned **27 athletic scholarships** to further their dreams at the collegiate level.

In closing, I would like to thank our wonderful parents who volunteer so many hours, serve in booster organizations, and support MVHS. A special thank you to our PTSO!

We appreciate the support of our Diablo Community for their patience as we navigate these unique times together.

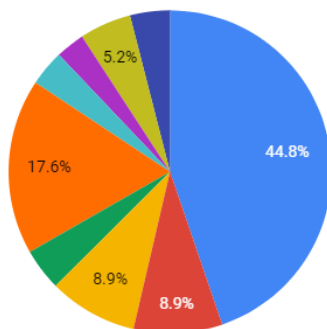

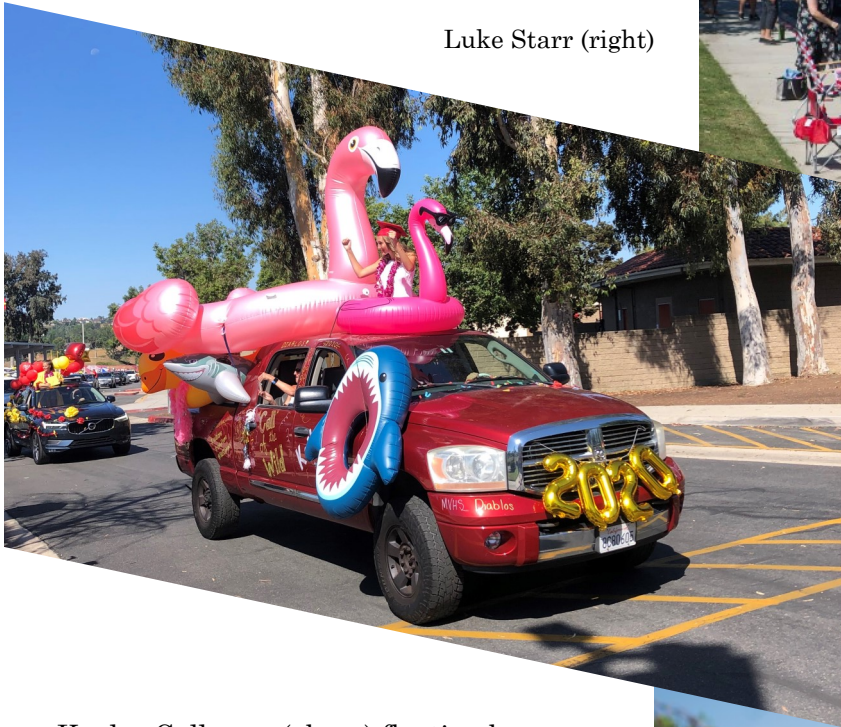

## The Show Must Go On...

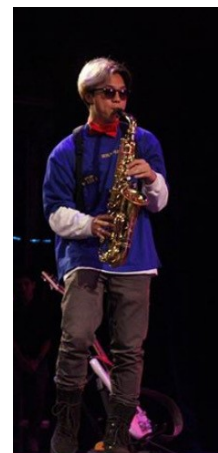

visualize fine particulate matter, multiple cloud layers, lightening strikes, and much more for

### Weather Impacting COVID-19 Management Strategies

#### Abstract

Tornadoes have always plagued the Midwest. With the recent pandemic, the damage they inflict adds another element to managing COVID-19 infections. I chose this topic because it is interesting to me and can be applied to other weather conditions, such as the Santa Ana winds we experience in Southern California. My goal was to research the Midwest's response to tornado season and find out how they adapted their management strategies to coincide with the pandemic. I used GOES-17 to learn more about storms and tornadoes and how the satellite images are used to warn people of severe weather. I discovered some management strategies that had to be implemented due to tornadoes. These include the allowance of public shelters, relaxation of social distancing during a weather crisis, and other necessary changes that still maintain in awareness of the virus. To conclude, tornadoes have had an impact on management strategies relating to COVID-19 in the Midwest, especially April through June, when tornadoes primarily occur there.

#### Research Question

How do tornadoes impact COVID-19 management strategies in the Midwest?

#### Future Research

- Other weather-related impacts during the pandemic such as the Santa Ana winds

#### Methods/Procedure

The GOES-R "Red" Visible Band (0.64  $\mu\text{m}$ )—useful for analyzing storms due to its fine spatial resolution—shows the development and growth of deep convection. The GOES-R "Clear" Infrared Band (10.35  $\mu\text{m}$ )—less sensitive than other infrared bands—showed the pulsing cloud-top infrared brightness temperatures about 35 minutes prior to the destructive tornado that moved through Basfield.

- Fear of COVID-19 is second priority to weather
- Tornado management strategies drastically change during pandemic
- FEMA maintains readiness for disaster and DHS increases disaster response
- GOES-R satellite imagery warns people of threats and allows them time to prepare
- Supplies instruments, imagery, and products with better spectral, spatial, and temporal resolution
- Provides resources to forecasters within 20 minutes of the hourly processing of GOES retrievals
- GOES-R lead times are typically between 30 to 50 minutes
- 283-dBZ intensity radar echo at -10°C altitude

#### Results

- Tornadoes severely impact management strategies of Midwest
- GOES-R satellite imagery allows tornado-prone areas to prepare for bad weather
- With so many places forced together—whether it be disaster response, repair, or emergency shelters—sometimes social distancing isn't always the best choice of action
- GOES-R provides warning forecasters with better situational awareness and predictive information that better their ability to monitor atmospheric conditions

#### Conclusion

Management strategies are forced to be altered to make room for old diseases such as bad weather, but it is possible to adapt and be resilient in this time of crisis. Simultaneously dealing with the severe pandemic and severe weather is not easy but with smart, informed modifications to management, we can overcome these "pandemics". Overall, tornadoes, and other sources of disaster, are important to know about in order to maintain a safe society and minimize damage done. GOES-R allows us to improve our situational awareness of weather events by informing forecasters and supporting NWS.

#### RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS

The states that are surrounded by warm waters and high humidity levels have more hurricanes, as opposed to states with cooler waters and lower humidity levels. In particular, Florida is extremely humid and has warm water due to its location near the Gulf of Mexico, while California has much cooler waters and lower humidity levels. This causes Florida to have more hurricanes while California is known to have fewer hurricanes. However, California's water currents are increasing in temperature as well as the influx in humidity up to 80%, which is well in the range of hurricane development.

#### CONCLUSION

Florida was a state of high humidity, warm currents, low rainfall water, and perfect weather. California has much less humidity, cooler water currents, and colder high and low. Because of this, we can conclude that humidity, temp of water currents, and rainfall water are a crucial role in the development of hurricanes that occur over a certain area.

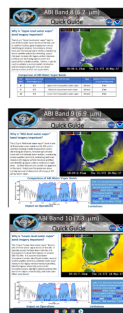
Our hypothesis was supported because we proved that hurricanes start in similar areas. We can help people with this information. We can use them by detecting hurricane faster.

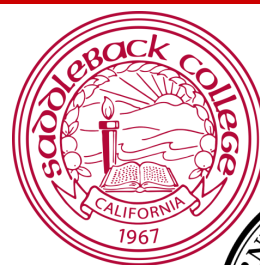

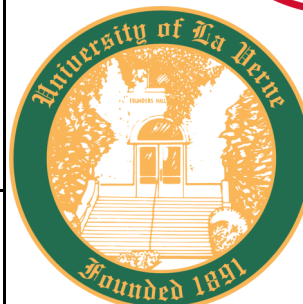
## Saddleback's Promise

## AVID Standout Student

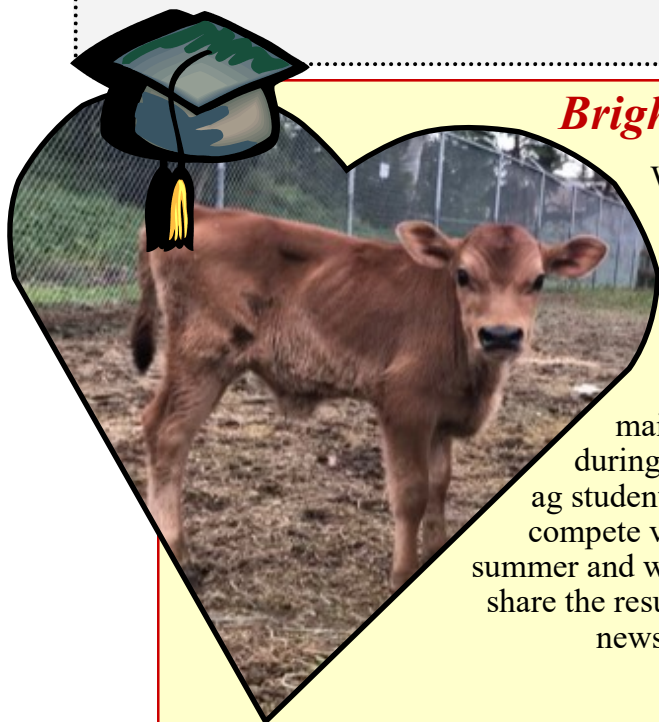
