J U S T F O L L O W T H E S E S T E P S :

Step 1: Know the A-G Requirements.

A. History/Social Science	2 years REQUIRED
B. English	4 years REQUIRED
C. Mathematics	3 years REQUIRED (<i>4 years recommended</i>)
D. Laboratory Science	2 years REQUIRED (<i>3 years recommended</i>)
E. Language Other than English	2 years REQUIRED (<i>3 years recommended</i>)
F. Visual & Performing Arts (VAPA)	1 yearlong course REQUIRED
G. College Prep Elective	1 year REQUIRED

Why is A-G important?

Completing the A-G Subject Requirements is one of the three requirements needed to enter a UC or CSU as a Freshman. Taking these courses will ensure you are well-prepared to succeed in college.

Step 3:

Pass A-G courses with a **C or better**.

Some colleges will have a GPA requirement in order to apply.

** Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 must be completed to be A-G eligible.

*** Earth Science counts as 1 year of Lab Science for CSU admission ONLY.

Step 4: Take the SAT or ACT.

UC admissions require ACT and SAT with writing.

Step 5: **APPLY** to your college/university of choice during your senior year.

** All Honors, AP, and IB levels of the above courses are approved for A-G.
