Honors (H)	Advanced Placement (AP)	International Baccalaureate (IB)
Honors courses move faster, go into greater depth and often require summer work.	An AP Course is a college level class that culminates with an exam that may earn college credit. AP tests are given primarily in grades 10-12 except for AP Human Geography.	An IB course is a college level course that has internal assessment and an exam that may earn college credit.

Students interested in the IB program take Honors and/or AP coursework in Grades 9 and 10. The IB program is a two-year program beginning junior year.
