Directions:

- Read the entire play. You can either print it out or read it from your computer.
- **Answer the pre-reading and post reading questions** in complete sentences. Whether you print the story or read it from the computer, you must write your answers in **COMPLETE SENTENCES**.

- **Identify two themes** (temas) in the play with a direct example from the story to support that theme. Write the themes and the direct text on the same sheet of paper as your answers to the questions. This should be done in Spanish as best you can.

Adjetivos (generalmente usados con “ser” porque describen aspectos de la personalidad de las personas): abierto, antipático, aplicado, bondadoso, caritativo, consentido, cortés/descortés, despreocupado, egoísta, engreído, embustero, enajenado, enojado/enfadado, entusiasta, exigente, exitoso, fiel/infiel, flojo, espeluznante, honesto/deshonesto, humilde, justo/injusto, leal/desleal, majo, malcriado, malvado, orgulloso, paciente/impaciente, perezoso, presumido, razonable, responsable, sabio, sencillo, sensible (sensitive, not sensible), serio, simpático, tenaz, terco/testarudo, torpe, valiente, vanidoso

Las condiciones (también adjetivos pero generalmente usados con “estar” porque son condiciones): agitado, agobiado, agotado, ansioso, avergonzado, celoso, distraído, nervioso

Sustantivos (nouns): la autoestima, el/la busca emociones, la confianza, el/la sinvergüenza, el estado de ánimo, la fe, la incertidumbre, la meta/el desafío, la sabiduría, trastorno

Verbos y frases: apoyar, desahogarse, emocionarse, disfrutar/gozar, equivocarse, experimentar (experience), lograr, superar/vencer (yo venzo)

TESTING on summer work will take place over a month: The summer work testing will be divided up as shown below. Please understand you need to know not just the conjugation of the verbs (with focus on the yo form, which is critical for present subjunctive), as well as know what they mean and how to use them in a sentence. For this reason it is divided up into four separate tests. Additionally, you need to know the vocabulary listed, as well as the article that goes with each word (noun).

Finally, the test on *El delantal blanco* will be about seven weeks into the school year to allow time for those who added AP at the last minute, or transferred to our school, to catch up & be read. There will be classroom discussion on the book as well.
