DEMERITS

Demerits are NEGATIVE POINTS!

You do not want negative points...you want to remain at ZERO POINTS!


Assigned a Lunch Detention = 1 Demerit (-1 point)
Serving a lunch detention (Removes the -1 point)

Assigned a Saturday School = 4 Demerits (-4 points)
Serving a Saturday School (Removes 6 points...bonus)

Students who get to 6 Demerits are placed on the Loss of Privilege List

The only way to come off of the L.O.P. list is to serve Detentions or Saturday Schools and get your point total back down to ZERO!!!!!

PRIVILEGES PROGRAM

If students behave inappropriately, they are expected to accept responsibility for their actions and subsequent consequences. While all students are encouraged to participate in school-wide activities and take advantage of the privileges afforded to them, there are times when the <u>loss of privileges</u> will be the result of failing to meet behavioral expectations.

ATTENDANCE

Always <u>check out</u> with the attendance office(if leaving early) Always <u>check in</u> with the attendance office (if absent or late)

There is no attendance call-in line

Absences must be cleared by note or email within <u>3 school days</u>

Email is MV/15atternalance <u>05VU50.000</u>

The note MUST:

- 1. Be handwritten in ink by the parent/guardian... NOT BY YOU!
- 2. Should include student's name, date of absence, and reason for the absence
- 3. <u>FORGERY</u>= "My mom/dad said I could write the note and they would just sign it" We have their signature/handwriting on file and we match the note



TRUANCIES



Truancy

- Absent without permission
- Not clearing an absence within three (3) school days
- Arriving to class more than 30 minutes late



SKATEBOARDS/BIKES

Bikes, Skateboards, Scooters, and Shoes with wheels may not be ridden on campus at anytime. Please do not leave these items in lockers, classrooms, or the office.

<u>Skateboards</u>

- MUST lock it up on the racks by the boys' locker room
- MUST bring your own lock
- MUST NOT leave it overnight or it may be cut off

TRAFFIC/PARKING

DRESS CODE



Clothing that disrupts the orderly operation of the campus or which could be construed as immodest, unsafe, or extreme is not permitted.

- 1. Gang-related
- 2. Clothing/Tattoos obscene, libelous, slanderous
- 3. Clothing/Accessories that can be used as weapons (No Spikes)
- 4. Clothing that is revealing, transparent, see-through, sides showings
- Shorts/Skirts torn, ripped, or frayed. Undergarments must not be visible
- 6. No hooded sweatshirts in class and no hooded sweatshirts that cover the face
- 7. No headwear is permitted in class.
- Not permitted to carry blankets or wear sleep attire (pajamas/slippers)
