Troop Leader

As a troop leader, you'll work as a team with other volunteers and parents to guide girls as they explore their interests, helping them develop leadership skills. Troop leaders will commit about 5-10 hours per month and hold 1-2 monthly meetings to guide girls in planning activities that help them discover, connect with others and take action so they experience fun and friendship while making the world a better place. They will ensure the safety of girls, communicate effectively with parents and volunteers, maintain troop records, and implement long term plans for the troop.

Troop Treasurer

Troop Treasurers manage the funds and keep the books for the troop. As a Troop Treasurer, you'll manage the troop bank account and budget, maintain financial records and submit a yearly financial report, and keep other volunteers, troop parents and council updated on financial status. As a Troop Treasurer, you can expect to commit about 2 hours per month.

Troop Helper

Troop Helpers provide an extra helping hand to support the troop leader. A Troop Helper may chaperone a field trip, help with meetings, drive girls to an event, or provide other volunteer support. Time commitment varies with the needs of the troop. Background screening is required.
