## **BINDERY ASSISTANT**

### **DEFINITION**

Under supervision, perform a variety of printing facilities functions; operate and maintain peripheral finishing equipment; and sort, count, and collate printed materials.

### **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES**

Operate auxiliary finishing equipment including collator, power stapler, paper drill, automated paper cutter, padding press, automatic folder, scoring and perforation equipment; sort, count, collate and wrap printed material; supply and stock paper for press and copier operators; deliver printed materials and maintain records of deliveries; maintain paper and card stock; clean, adjust and maintain equipment; operate forklift, pallet jack, hand truck, and electric cart to transport paper and printed materials, lift and move cartons of paper; file print records and occasionally operates a photocopier.

Print Shop methods, materials, and machinery; practices and procedures for cleaning and maintaining print shop equipment; filing and record-keeping; safe and efficient operation of equipment.
