#### MAINTENANCE/PAINTER

# **DEFINITION**

Under general direction, to perform skilled and semi-skilled maintenance painting work in protecting and decorating building surfaces; and to do related work as required.

## **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES**

Apply paints, varnishes, stains and enamels to building interiors and exteriors, furniture and equipment; apply waterproofing as appropriate to building interiors; assist in automotive refinishing; apply paints by brush, roller or spray machine to a variety of surfaces; do line striping of courts, parking lots, athletic fields and the like; do stencil painting of curbs, signs and seats; erect scaffolding and remove or cover objects to protect them; prepare or clean surfaces by sandblasting, scraping, burning, sanding, sealing, or washing, and by puttying and patching holes and cracks; clean brushes and see that tools and equipment are properly maintained; make roof and glass repairs; may mix and match colors; create and maintain painting maintenance schedule; some re-roofing involving rolled roofing, reflective coating and flashing; may use forklift if OSHA training is current; and maintain clean and safe work and shop areas.

# **QUALIFICATIONS**

## Knowledge of

Methods, materials, and equipment used in the painting trade; and proper painting ventilation procedures.

#### Ability to

Mix and match paints; blend, harmonize and contrast colors; correctly apply paints with brush, roller or spray gun; after appropriate training safely use machines, equipment, and tools related to job duties; skillfully use and care for painting tools and equipment; prepare scaffolds and work from them and ladders; use district work order system; understand and carry out oral and written instructions; and work cooperatively with others.

# **Experience**

Three years of varied experience in painting work.

# **Education**

Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade.

#### Physical Performance Requirements

Frequent heavy lifting and maneuvering of up to 50 to 60 pounds with occasionally lifting and maneuvering of up to 100 pounds, with or without assistance. Twisting, bending, stooping, standing, walking, and squatting also required. May work on irregular surfaces or at heights above the ground.

## Licenses

Possession of a valid and appropriate California Driver's License required.
