SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL: 5% between 12:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. 10% between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. (Article IV, Section E)

CHILD CARE/ELOP

SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL: Child Care/ELOP Leaders who are assigned an afternoon shift and agree to work an additional morning shift, opening at 7:00 a.m., will receive a 20% shift differential stipend of the a.m. hours worked, with a minimum of 1.5 hours.

LONGEVITY: \$52.57/month; beginning with the sixth year of service for those who entered into the program prior to 07/01/1994. Effective 07/01/1994, entry into the program will begin with the eighth year of service. Both programs will continue through the 24th year of service. Employees with 25 years or more of service will receive the same stipend they will be receiving on 06/30/1994. (Article IV, Section F)

FIRST AID CERTIFICATE: 2.5% stipend for a valid, District-approved First Aid Certificate, including CPR Certificate. (Article IV, Section G)

FOOD SAFETY CERTIFICATE: 1% stipend effective 01/01/2000 for designated employees with a valid, District-approved Food Safety Certificate. (Article IV, Section H)

BILINGUAL: 1% stipend effective 02/09/2000 for employees in designated positions requiring skills in a second language. (Article IV, Section I)

SPECIALIZED HEALTH CARE: 4% stipend effective 03/01/2008, or 2% stipend, for employees in designated positions performing specialized health care procedures. (Article IV, Section J)

PROFESSIONAL GROWTH: \$13.71/month per unit with a maximum 75 units. Quarter units will be converted on a 2/3 basis. (Article IV, Section L)

PRESCHOOL CONNECTION: The Manager of the Child Care/ELOP Division may designate Mentor Teachers for this program. Individuals designated as mentors shall receive a 5% stipend.

INITIAL STEP PLACEMENT: A new employee shall be placed on Step "A" of the salary range applicable to his/her classification and shall be advanced one (1) step upon completion of his/her probationary period. Upon verification of prior experience, the Director of Classified Personnel, in consultation with the supervisor, may authorize a new employee to be placed on the salary schedule no higher than Step "C".

STEP PLACEMENT: Any new employee shall be eligible to advance from step to step on the salary schedule upon reaching his/her anniversary date.

When members of the regular classified service serve a portion of their day in an exempt status, the exempt status regulations as per Education Code 45103 apply to that portion of time in an exempt status, and the other regulations of the classified service apply at other times.

NOTE: Your final monthly pay may fluctuate by several cents due to rounding in the OCDE payroll system.
