Site:

- A/C issues (recently replaced) break downs
- Public Bathroom needed
- Lounge for staff
- Rain cover would be nice
- Update furniture throughout
- Ponding in playfields – better maintenance, poor sprinklers, new baseball, community bathrooms
- Paging system does not perform adequately
- Not enough security cameras/better cameras
- Building is not properly lighted
- Some issues with the fire alarm
- Sometimes the roof leaks when it rains
- Solar panels coming
- Better signage
- All playgrounds need upgraded equipment

Next Generation Classroom:

- Moveable and flexible furniture
- Multiple monitors per class (inter activity)
- Whiteboards walls, - all and more
- Mobile white boards, desk whiteboards
- LED lighting
- Larger media center
- Flexible furniture
- Mobile shelves
- Collaboration spaces
- Collaborative learning (student centered)
- Resources room, glass
- Expand outdoor, grow garden, learner space
- Portables? Not bad, update furniture
- Mic wired classroom for teachers
- Not all classrooms have adequate technology (need flat screens, need 1:1 Chromebooks and new projector doc cameras)

Technology:

- One to one technology
- Collaboration team with monitor
- Video display
- Integrate computer lab technology

Support Space:

- New carpet needed
- Kindergarten needs a bigger yard
- In the daylight – blinds are an issue
- Covered areas – moving between classrooms – over hanging
- Larger MPR needed for more than 400 students
- More storage needed
- Add dedicated resource space
- Office – visibility, direct, and secure
- More office space
- Need more rooms to dedicate to special programs – specifically a maker space
- Sound projector system does not work adequately
- Not enough room for administration
- Not enough storage
- Not enough space for the nurse

General:

- Original design cap was 700 then the District added portables and the cap is now 1200
