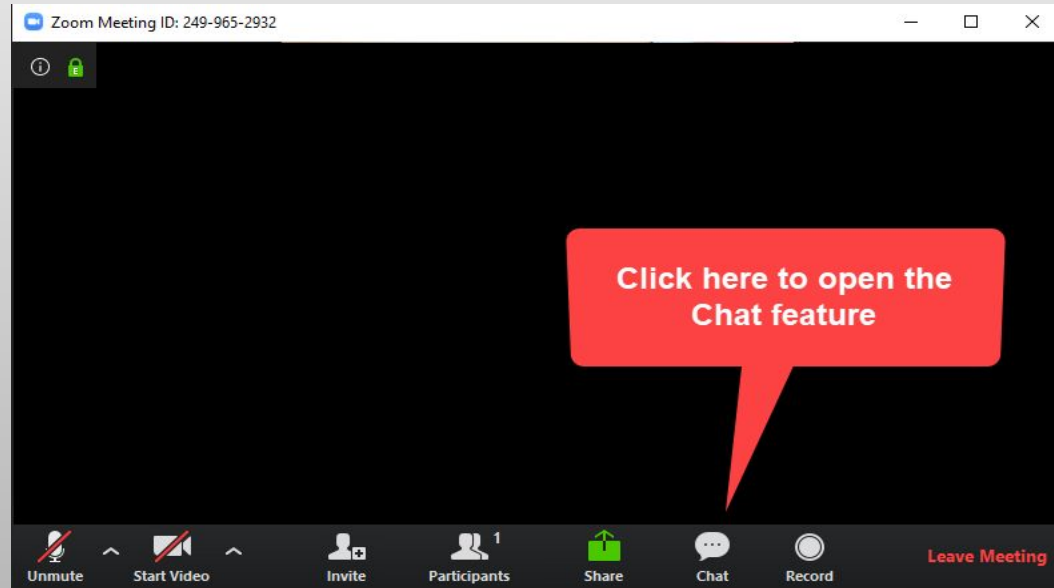

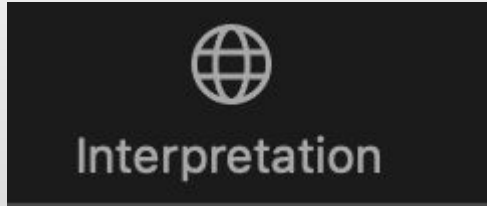

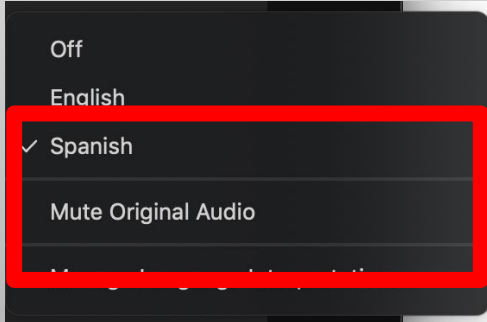

Covid Vaccine and Testing Protocols for Visitors and Volunteers



What Do Volunteers Do?

Volunteers can be on site at a school campus, supporting school functions. This could include working at on-campus PTA events such as appreciation luncheons and awards events, in snack bars at sporting events, as field-trip chaperones, and at all other school events that require volunteers.



How Do Volunteers Report to School Sites?

For School Site Volunteers:

- *When volunteers are checking in (at front office, via Raptor), they must provide a vaccine card or the results of a negative Covid test in the last week, along with a driver's license.*
- *If volunteers provide a vaccine record, it will be recorded on the school site spreadsheet, and the volunteers won't need to continually provide a card.*
- *For individuals providing a negative Covid test, this would need to be provided every time they volunteer on campus and be taken at a lab within the previous 7 days (no home tests allowed).*

TK Registration



TK Registration dates have not been published yet for 2022-2023 school year
Applications will be available online for the 2022-2023 school year at 8:00 a.m.
for children born September 2 - December 2, 2017

Step 1. Apply - Priority school site placement is given if you apply early

Step 2. Notify - Families are notified of TK placement via email from district office personnel in April

Step 3. Register - Complete enrollment at assigned school site as soon as possible for start time preference

School Choice



The School Choice Intra-District Transfer is the process for SVUSD residents who want to transfer their students to another school within SVUSD:

Elementary School Choice dates are *January 3, 2022 - January 21, 2022* for incoming Kinders through 6th grade for the 2022-2023 school year.

Secondary School Choice dates are *January 17, 2022 - February 4, 2022* for incoming students 7th - 12th grade for the 2022-2023 school year.

Kindergarten Round Up



Registration for students is conducted online and it usually begins in March

- *Create an account on Aeris Internet Registration (AIR)
Create a new account or login if you already have one*
- *You will need to gather the following documents to complete the registration process*
 - *Complete Immunization Record*
 - *Proof of Age (Birth Certificate, Passport, Baptism Certificate)*
 - *Proof of Residency (Two bills: utility bill and mortgage/lease agreement)*
