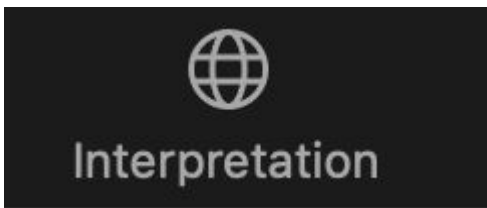

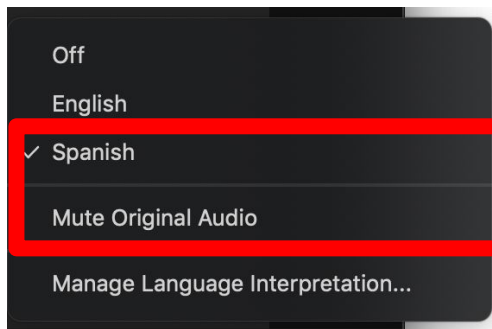

Survey Topics



Barriers to Engagement/Los obstáculos para el compromiso

Factors that can create challenges for families to interact with or become involved with their child's school. Survey-takers responded to the question, "How big of a problem are the following issues for becoming involved with your child's current school?"

Family Engagement/El compromiso familiar

The degree to which families become involved with and interact with their child's school.

School Climate/El entorno escolar

Perceptions of the overall social and learning climate of the school.

School Fit/El ajuste escolar

Families' perceptions of how well a school matches their child's developmental needs.

School Safety/La Seguridad Escolar

Perceptions of student physical and psychological safety at school.

What is "Percent Favorable"?

A score of "82% favorable" means that 82% of respondents selected a favorable answer choice. Most often, the top 2 answer choices are favorable for a question with 5 answer choices.

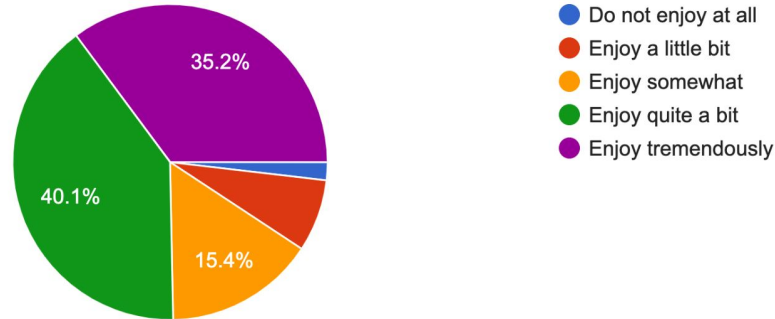

Percent Favorable - Example Question

For this question, 75.3% of respondents answered favorably on the English version of the survey (“enjoy quite a bit” + “enjoy tremendously”).
