Safety Report

- Hired a Safety Consultant - Henrie Watkins
 - Conducted site walks at all school sites
 - identified hazards, exposures, risks, threats and vulnerabilities
 - rated schools
 - provided recommendations
 - close gaps in perimeter barriers
 - enhance CCTV systems to include approach surveillance
 - upgrade emergency equipment to include Stop The Bleed Kits
 - enhance staff emergency response training
 - enhance emergency response protocols and exercise methods
 - enforce use identification badges by staff and visitors
 - monitor trees and hillsides for signs of concern
- Doug will send updated maps to each school site
- Working on reunification areas for each school site

Upcoming Projects

- Perimeter fencing and closing gaps at identified school sites
- A.I. enhanced perimeter video surveillance pilot program
- Expanding and revising training
- Supply orders and replenishment

Recent Safety Measures

- Grant from OC Supervisors to pilot video surveillance and purchase additional EOC radios for each school site
- Purchased and distributed Narcan at all of the secondary sites and awaiting delivery of Narcan to distribute to elementary sites
 - Lifespan of Narcan is about 2/3 years
- Tabletop exercises for all secondary schools individually and elementary schools in groups



Update on Supply Order

- Additional backpacks and buckets were distributed to school sites
- In the process of purchasing Stop the Bleed Kits for every classroom and discussing training
- Gathering a list for inventory for the emergency storage bins

Mission Viejo Tabletop Exercise

- Training on current processes and what could be done to improve
- Really beneficial if sites are honest

OC Grand Jury

- Comprised of retired judges
- This year the grand jury interviewed every district in regards to school safety and will provide their recommendations in a report that's released in July 2023.
