



**State Public Health Order dated September 13, 2022  
September 14, 2022**

Hello SVUSD Community,

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, Saddleback Valley Unified School District (SVUSD) has kept the safety, health, and well-being of its students and employees as a top priority.

In the recently issued [State Public Health Order of September 13, 2022](#), CDPH (California Department of Public Health) announced that the [State Public Health Officer Order of August 11, 2021](#) has been rescinded effective September 17, 2022.

**Beginning Saturday, September 17, 2022:**

- **Employees are no longer required to submit vaccination status**
- **Unvaccinated employees are no longer required to complete weekly COVID-19 testing**
- **Volunteers are no longer required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative test in order to volunteer at school sites**

The District will continue to follow guidance from the California Department of Public Health and Orange County Health Care Agency and communicate any changes with the community.
