INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

- 1.1. The CONTRACTOR, at the CONTRACTOR's own cost and expense, shall procure and maintain, for the duration of the contract, the following insurance policies:
 - 1.1.1. Workers' Compensation Coverage. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance for its employees in accordance with the laws of the State of California. In addition, the CONTRACTOR shall require any and every subcontractor to similarly maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance in accordance with the laws of the State of California for all of the subcontractor's employees. Any notice of cancellation or non-renewal of all Workers' Compensation policies must be received by the DISTRICT at least thirty (30) days prior to such change. The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the DISTRICT, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by the CONTRACTOR for District.
 - 1.1.2. General Liability Coverage. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain commercial general liability insurance in an amount of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. If a commercial general liability insurance form or other form with a general aggregate limit is used, either the general aggregate limit shall apply separately to the work to be performed under this Agreement or the general aggregate limit shall be at least twice the required occurrence limit.
 - 1.1.3. Automobile Liability Coverage. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain automobile liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage for all activities of the CONTRACTOR arising out of or in connection with the work to be performed under this Agreement, including coverage for owned, hired, and non-owned vehicles, in an amount of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) combined single limit for each occurrence.
- 1.2. Endorsements. Each general liability and automobile liability insurance policy shall be issued by insurers possessing a Best's rating of no less than A-:VII.

- 1.2.1. "The DISTRICT, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of work performed by or on behalf of the CONTRACTOR, including materials, parts, or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations."
- 1.2.2. This policy shall be considered primary insurance as respects the DISTRICT, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers. Any insurance maintained by the DISTRICT, including any self-insured retention the DISTRICT may have, shall be considered excess insurance only and shall not contribute with this policy.
- 1.2.3. This insurance shall act for each insured and additional insured as though a separate policy had been written for each, except with respect to the limits of liability of the insuring company.
- 1.2.4. CONTRACTOR acknowledges that the insurance coverage and policy limits set forth in this section constitute the minimum amounts of coverage required. Any insurance proceeds available to the DISTRICT in excess of the limits and coverage required in this agreement and which is applicable to a given loss, will be available to the DISTRICT.
- 1.2.5. The insurer waives all rights of subrogation against the DISTRICT, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, or agents regardless of the applicability of any insurance proceeds, and agrees to require all subcontractors to do likewise.
- 1.2.6. Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policies shall not affect coverage provided to the District, its elected or appointed officers, officials, employees, agents, or volunteers.
- 1.2.7. The insurance provided by this policy shall not be suspended, voided or reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days' written notice has been submitted to the DISTRICT and approved of in writing, except in the case of cancellation, for which ten (10) days' written notice shall be provided.
- 1.2.8. Contractor agrees to provide immediate notice to District of any claim or loss against Contractor arising out of the work performed under this agreement. District assumes no obligation or liability by such notice, but has the right (but not the duty) to

monitor the handling of any such claim or claims if they are likely to involve District.

1.3. Certificates of Insurance. The CONTRACTOR shall provide certificates of insurance with original endorsements to the DISTRICT as evidence of the insurance coverage required herein. Certificates of such insurance shall be filed with the DISTRICT on or before commencement of performance of this Agreement. Current certification of insurance shall be kept on file with the DISTRICT at all times during the term of this Agreement. The CONTRACTOR shall provide written evidence of current automobile coverage to comply with the automobile insurance requirement.
